

## EV Add On Eligibility Criteria

- (1) The Electric Vehicle Add On product (EV Add On) is a time of use tariff offered by Synergy which is subject to the eligibility criteria set out below.

The EV Add On comprises of a daily supply charge and different variable electricity charge rates for different time bands at the rates set out on Synergy's website. The current rates and time band periods are currently available here: <https://www.synergy.net.au/Your-home/Energy-plans/Electric-Vehicle-Add-On>

Synergy will notify you, in accordance with the terms of your electricity supply agreement, if any of the rates or time band periods change.

- (2) For the purposes of these eligibility criteria, an **Electric Vehicle** means a plug in vehicle that is propelled either solely by one or more electric battery motors, or by a hybrid arrangement of an internal combustion engine and one or more electric battery motors.
- (3) You are only eligible for the EV Add On if you meet the following eligibility criteria:
  - (a) you must be a residential customer who has entered into an electricity supply agreement with Synergy;
  - (b) your residential address must be a dwelling (being a house, flat, home unit or other place of residence) used solely for domestic purposes;
  - (c) the amount of electricity supplied by Synergy to your residential address must be less than 50MW hours per annum;
  - (d) an Electric Vehicle must be registered under:
    - (i) your name;
    - (ii) the name of another party that resides at the same residential address as you; or
    - (iii) a registered business name,
  - (e) the Electric Vehicle in (3)(d) must be registered with the Western Australian Department of Transport
    - (i) at your residential address; or
  - (f) if the Electric Vehicle is a fleet vehicle in your control or the Electric Vehicle is subject to a novated lease in your control then your application as per section 4 of these terms and conditions must be accompanied by a copy of the Electric Vehicle registration as per conditions 4(c)
  - (g) your meter is capable of recording your consumption during the relevant time band periods, which will normally require the installation of a compatible time of use meter or reprogramming of an existing time of use meter at your residential premises.
- (4) You must apply for the EV Add On by lodging an electronic application via the Synergy website (application form currently available here: [selfserve.synergy.net.au/ev-add-on.html](https://selfserve.synergy.net.au/ev-add-on.html)) The electronic application requires you to:
  - (a) provide consent to pay any metering charges associated with the installation of a compatible time of use meter or reprogramming of an existing meter; and

- (b) is supported by a declaration that:
    - (i) your dwelling is used solely for domestic purposes; and
    - (ii) the amount of electricity supplied to your premises will be less than 50MW hours per annum;
    - (iii) You, the Electric Vehicle and the premises meet the eligibility criteria; and
  - (c) is accompanied by a copy of the Electric Vehicle registration which clearly demonstrates that you meet the relevant eligibility criteria.
- (5) The EV Add On tariff will commence on the date Synergy notifies you that it has accepted your application and will be reflected on your first bill following this date .
- (6) The eligibility criteria for the Synergy EV Add On product is subject to change by Synergy at any time
